Avoid a 'soupy' mix; too much water will weaken the concrete, mortar or stucco mix.

The mixture should be mixed for 3 to 5 minutes after all materials are in the mixer. Use of a machine mixer is recommended to ensure all ingredients are thoroughly combined.

Adhering to recommended amounts of Ash Grove® White Portland Cement, sand, gravel and/or lime is very important to ensure superior physical properties.
